Statue of Liberty

In 1884, France gave a special gift to the United States. Artist Frederic Bartholdi designed a statue of a woman holding a tablet and a torch to stand for liberty (Freedom).

On August 5, 1884, the Statue of Liberty's base was laid on Bedloe's Island (now named Liberty Island) in New York harbor. Finishing the statue was not so easy, though. The project ran out of money. Americans had to give over \$100,000 (worth more than 2 million dollars today) to help pay for it.

The statue was built in France, but it had to be taken apart and shipped piece by piece in boxes. When the Statue of Liberty was finally put together again in New York, President Grover Cleveland dedicated it on October 28, 1886. For many years, people who moved from Europe to the United States would watch for "Lady Liberty" from their ships. She was a symbol of the freedom these immigrants would have in their new country. The Statue of Liberty is 305 feet and one inch tall from ground to torch, and visitors can seven climb to the crown now!
