The Perfect Costume

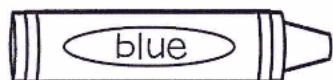

The man at the counter apologized. "Sorry, kid, but we're all out."

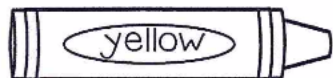

Ben was still sad. His dad said he was sorry for waiting so long and took him right to the craft store to get costume supplies.

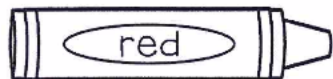

Who drove Ben to the craft store?



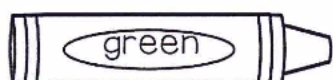
What did Ben learn this Halloween?



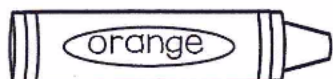
Where did Ben's dad take him to get supplies?
