
"It's just one piece of paper, J.J. Not that big of a deal!" Dante replied. "I mean, look at that trash can. I'm not the only one!"

"That's the problem!" J.J. said. "It's not just one piece of paper. It all adds up! Wasting paper means more trees have to be cut down."


"Hey!" Dante exclaimed. "What if we put a recycling bin next to every trash can, so we could recycle that paper instead of throwing it away?"


"We could do that!" cried J.J. "We can be the Recycling Club!"

Who threw paper away at the beginning of the story?




From **what** is paper created?
